LONDON TOWER'S BRIDGE

London's Tower Bridge is one of the most (17)_____ bridges in the world. The bridge, designed by the architect Horace Jones together with John Wolfe Barry, was finally (18) _____ in 1894. It took 11,000 tons of steel to build the framework of the 265-meter-long bridge. Over time, the bridge has become one of London's most famous symbols.

The long glass floors, more than 40 meters above the river, allow you to watch the traffic over the Tower Bridge from above. But acid rain, industrial pollution and garbage have made many sources of water undrinkable. Lakes, reservoirs and even entire seas have become vast pools of poison. Lake Baikal in Russia is one of the largest lakes in the world. It contains a rich variety of animals and plants, including 1,300 rare species that do not exist anywhere else in the world.
